Mr Johal's Report

- <u>Enrollment</u>: This year we have 426 students, and 21 divisions. The teaching staff has seen very little turnover with only 2-3 staff moving. This is a positive reflection of our school being a desirable place to work.
- <u>Staff collaboration days:</u> Staff are using a district grant to participate in a 4-part series of professional development. The focus is on helping students with self-regulation and following agreements, and creating stimulating classrooms. As part of this focus, each class has been allocated designated entry and exit doors based on where their classroom is in order to create more order during transition times.
- Key dates:
