Roles To Fill:

DROP OFF & PICK UP REMINDER

For drivers who are dropping off, please do so quickly while remaining in your vehicle and use only the designated DROP OFF / PICK UP zones. **Remember:**

- The school's parking lot is for staff use only. Do not use this area as a drop off zone.
- There is absolutely no stopping or parking in the cul-de-sac or in front of the fire hydrant located across the street from the school.
- Avoid dropping your child off anywhere close to the crosswalk. Please use the drop off zones.
- Take advantage of the parking lot behind the school (Roche Point Park) or the Drive to 5 zones located at Dollarton Village, Felton Road (off Dollar), or Caddy Road (off Fairway). It is only a five minute walk from these areas and a good chance to have some quality time with your child.
